Dear General Secretary and President of the each Executive Committee for BSPC,

Sub: REQUISITIONS BY GENERAL MEMBERS FOR HOLDING A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING (SGM) AS PER THE CLAUSE 30(2) OF THE BSPC CONSTITUTION.

We, the undersigned general members, refer to the current conflict amongst some members and to the existence of two executive committees for one organization.

We also refer to the correspondence from the Office of Fair Trading ("OFT") dated 16/12/09 advising options to resolve internal disputes and finally instructing general members to elect a single Executive Committee to avoid deregistration of BSPC.

We note that, after receiving such clear instructions from OFT, some of the general members also have taken personal initiatives to facilitate communication between two BCs, however, without success, which are evident by a number of email correspondences published in two separate email groups.

We also note that none of the parties have so far obtained any legal verdict (Judgment from any appropriate Authority) in their favour to claim their existence as a valid executive committee to represent members of the Society, despite being advised in the said letter from OFT that, "In the absence of members' ability or willingness to resolve the dispute it would seem the only option available is for the relevant parties to make application to the Supreme Court".

Under the above circumstances, we the undersigned, are in the opinion that both BCs are not coming forward effectively or failed to reconcile or to end conflict by themselves and to take an effective

initiative to form a single committee or to take any legal step to confirm validity of their individual group and finally failed to take any reasonable step to save BSPC from possible deregistration.

Therefore, we the undersigned general members (as required by the constitution of BSPC) under Clause 30(2) as well as specified advice from OFT hereby put both Executive Committees on Notice that we request for a Special General Meeting called immediately as per the Constitution.

This requisition proposes the following Agenda and the Special Resolutions, which require 21 days Notice to the members for such an SGM to be held and according to the clause 30(4), the SGM requested by way requisitions should be convened to be held within one month of the date of the requisition. Therefore, we request both ECs to action this Notice of SGM within seven days of the date of this Notice.

The SGM will be commenced by both the President of the presently existing two Executive Committees and instantly elect a Financial Member present at the SGM to preside the SGM.

The Agenda and Special Resolutions to be passed in the requested SGM are as follows:

Proposed Agenda:

1. As directed by OFT, election/formation of a single Executive Committee by the members, (Financial Members, who were members as at the SGM held on 20 September 2008 when a single EC was running the societal affairs).
2. Pass all special resolutions as listed below.
3. Confirmation of the Public Officer as per Constitution.
4. Miscellaneous.

Proposed Resolution 1: *Both Executive Committees who are currently running the business of BSPC separately are dissolved at the commencement of the SGM.*

Proposed Resolution 2: *A Financial Member present at the SGM is appointed as Election Commissioner (nominated and elected) immediately after dissolution of both committees and to conduct the election for a single Executive Committee for the term 2009-2010.*

Proposed Resolution 3: *Eligible members as per the Constitution will submit their nominations within one hour of the announcement of the Election Commissioner to submit nominations for the positions of the Executives.*

Proposed Resolution 4: *The Election is instantly conducted by the Election Commissioner and the newly elected EC is declared at the SGM.*

Proposed Resolution 5: *The newly elected Executive Committee to submit the name of the EC elected at this SGM to the Office of Fair Trading as well as Public Officer.*

Proposed Resolution 6: *In conformation of the Constitution, the General Secretary of the newly elected Executive Committee to act as the Public Officer.*

Proposed Resolution 7: *Any person or group who further claims as Executive Committee of BSPC and or use the name of this organization, BSPC, for any activity without written permission from this newly elected single Executive Committee, will be given Legal Notice and if does not comply, legal proceedings should be initiated against the individual or group.*












We request both Executive Committees to call an SGM as requested above within the time as per the Clause 30(2) of the Constitution. If we do not receive Notice for the above requisitioned SGM called (preferably by both parties mutually), we the undersigned members will hold an SGM according to the Constitution on the above said Agenda and Special Resolutions, at a suitable venue on a suitable date prior to the end of the deadline date of 31st March 2010.

This is a very special and critical situation for the Society and hence we would request both General Secretary and their committee members to consider the matter at their utmost priority and urgency to avoid possible deregistration of BSPC.
